JSS College of Physiotherapy organized a one-week free camp for Osteoarthritis (OA) patients from 12th September, 2022 to 17th September 2022 as part of World Physiotherapy Day 2022 with the theme OA – Physiotherapy management and prevention at JSS college of Physiotherapy campus, Ramanuja Road, Mysuru. The camp was conducted by the Department of Musculoskeletal Sciences, JSS college of Physiotherapy, which specializes in assessment and management of Musculoskeletal disorders and dysfunctions. Dr.Renukadevi M, vice-Principal, JSSCPT and Mr. Vijay Samuel Raj V, Associate Professor, JSSCPT, inaugurated the camp along with the participants of the camp. 26 participants were participated in the camp.
