We were extremely fortunate to have with us our eminent guest for the day, Dr.



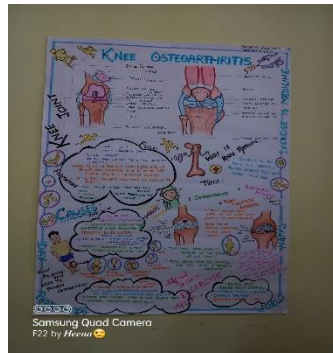
