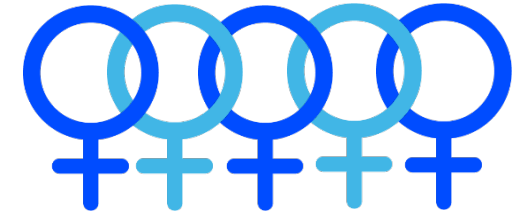

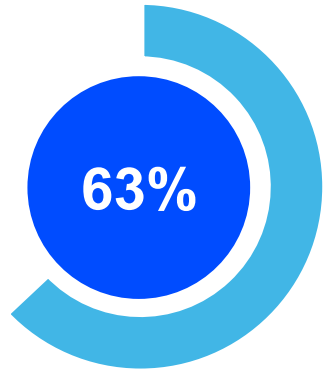


percentage of physiotherapists that are members of a World Physiotherapy member organisation

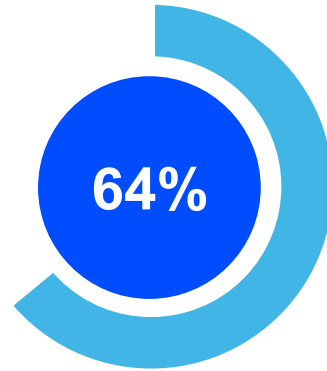

NUMBER OF PRACTISING PHYSIOTHERAPISTS PER 10,000 POPULATION

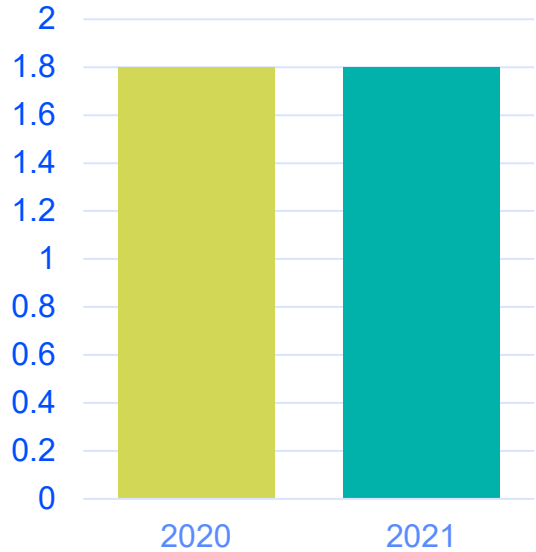
