











VIETNAM PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION

Vietnam Physical Therapy Association has **increased its membership by 136**% during the last year. The association **became a World Physiotherapy member organisation** in January 2021 and developed a number of strategies to increase engagement, including:

- o inviting international experts to deliver online CPD courses and providing interpretation for all courses
- ensuring individual members knew about the bursary programme to attend World Physiotherapy Congress 2021 online and encouraging people to apply
- promoting the benefits to individual members, and potential members, of membership of World
 Physiotherapy
- contacting physiotherapy students and encouraging them to become individual members on graduation and take part in different activities within universities, ministry of health, or hospitals
- making regular posts on social media about individual members to create a sense of belonging and raise the profile of the association and individual members
