























ASIA WESTERN PACIFIC DIRECT ACCESS

of countries/territories in the Asia 50% Western Pacific region have full direct **access** to physiotherapy services



HONG KONG – INCREASE IN MEMBERSHIP

The Hong Kong Physiotherapy Association (HKPA) has increased its membership by 48% in the past 12 months. This was achieved through a number of actions, including:

- to celebrate HKPA's 60th anniversary, life membership was offered at a special 50% discount
- new physiotherapy graduates were offered a 50% discount rate if they applied for life membership within the first year of graduation
- highlighting the benefits of becoming a member to access the member rate to take part in HKPA's CPD courses
- securing time for HKPA presentations to promote the benefits of student membership to year 1 physiotherapy students on their orientation day and recruit them as student members. Once registered as HKPA student members, they are eligible to join HKPA's structured 1-year student engagement programme and, on completion, receive a certificate to acknowledge their contributions.

- The AMC was sent to 127 member organisations, of which 119 responded, representing a 93.7% response rate. This is consistent with previous years' response rates and demonstrates strong engagement between World Physiotherapy and its member organisations. The census date was 30 June 2023.
