

World Physiotherapy Day 2024 Celebrations by the School of Physiotherapy, RK University




at raising awareness about workplace ergonomics and promoting community health. The involvement of RK University's experienced faculty and dedicated scholars ensured the success of the event.



Specialized Camp at Falcon Pumps, Rajkot


(7th September 2024): Industry workers were offered free low back pain screenings, physiotherapy education, and treatment. This event focused on improving the workers' overall health and quality of life.




