Background

The PASS is a medical Association of Physiotherapy professionals in the field of Rehabilitation Medicine, not curative or preventive medicines, which promote, maintain high standard of clinical ethics, code of conduct, high standard of knowledge and skills in the field of physiotherapy in accordance with the national, Regional and International standards.

PASS represents physiotherapists at national and state levels and promotes physiotherapy profession to the

Government and community; provides on going professional development for physiotherapists and protect the reputation and interests of physiotherapists to develop their career. The PASS is not representing doctors or other health professionals but we are in a multi-displinary team or partners in Rehabilitation that provide health care services in hospitals, health Centers/clinics, and Rehabilitation Centers.

On the Celebration of the World Physiotherapy (WPT) Day, PASS organized different activities and awareness program such as Radio talk show, presentations, speeches from the invited guests, exhibition, blood donation and Evidence Based Practice – on patients suffering from LBP at Juba Military Hospital (JMH) from 08TH -09TH September 2024 under the theme: "Low Back Pain" (LBP).

Organization of the day

The day was organized by PASS in collaboration with International Committee of Red Cross ICRC and ICRC also funded the occasion by 90%. HERAPY ASSO

Participants

350 participants attended the occasion from various works of life including ICRC head of Operation and other staffs, SSRC, invited Guests e.g. representative from the office undersecretary National Ministry of Health, Provost and Vice Chancellor St Mary's University, Dean of Rehabilitation Sciences St. Mary's University, Director General Juba National Referral Hospital, Director General Juba Military Hospital. Out of 350 participants, PASS President & PASS Executives, Physiotherapists, Physiotherapy Students, other staffs of the hospital and patients.

Activities of the 2-Days

First day activity on 8th Sep 2024

On 08th September 2024, PASS carried out public awareness on the National Radio South Sudan Broadcasting Cooperation (SSBC) on the theme: "Low Back Pain" and the role of physiotherapists in its management and prevention using various techniques mainly Manual Therapy, Educations and Exercises. Mary's University the only institution in the country training Physiotherapists, Dean of school of Rehabilitation Science, ST Mary's college; Blood Donation Coordinator from South Sudan Red Cross (SSRC), PASS President, all the speeches focus on the importance of Physiotherapists in health care system especially in helping or managing people with various disabilities and health conditions, restoring function and giving them hope.
