

A detailed screening camp was organized during school to assess posture, flexibility, musculoskeletal health, and Work-Related Musculoskeletal Disorders (WMSDs).

Screening was carried out for both primary teachers (7:00 AM - 01:00 PM) and secondary teachers (12:00 PM- 5:00PM), aligned with their regular working schedules.

Among students, screening focused on postural abnormalities such as scoliosis, flat feet, rounded shoulders, and forward head posture.

Teachers' screening helped identify common WMSD issues and guided them on preventive measures.

Description of Activity:


