

# DEPARTMENT OF MUSCULOSKELETAL SCIENCES













# **DEPARTMENT OF PEDIATRIC AND NEONATAL SCIENCES**







They conducted physiotherapy assessments that focused on mobility, fall prevention, posture and suggested the age-appropriate exercises for the elderly population to promote active, healthy living.





#### **DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS SCIENCES**



## **DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY, GERIATRICS & PALLIATIVE CARE**




